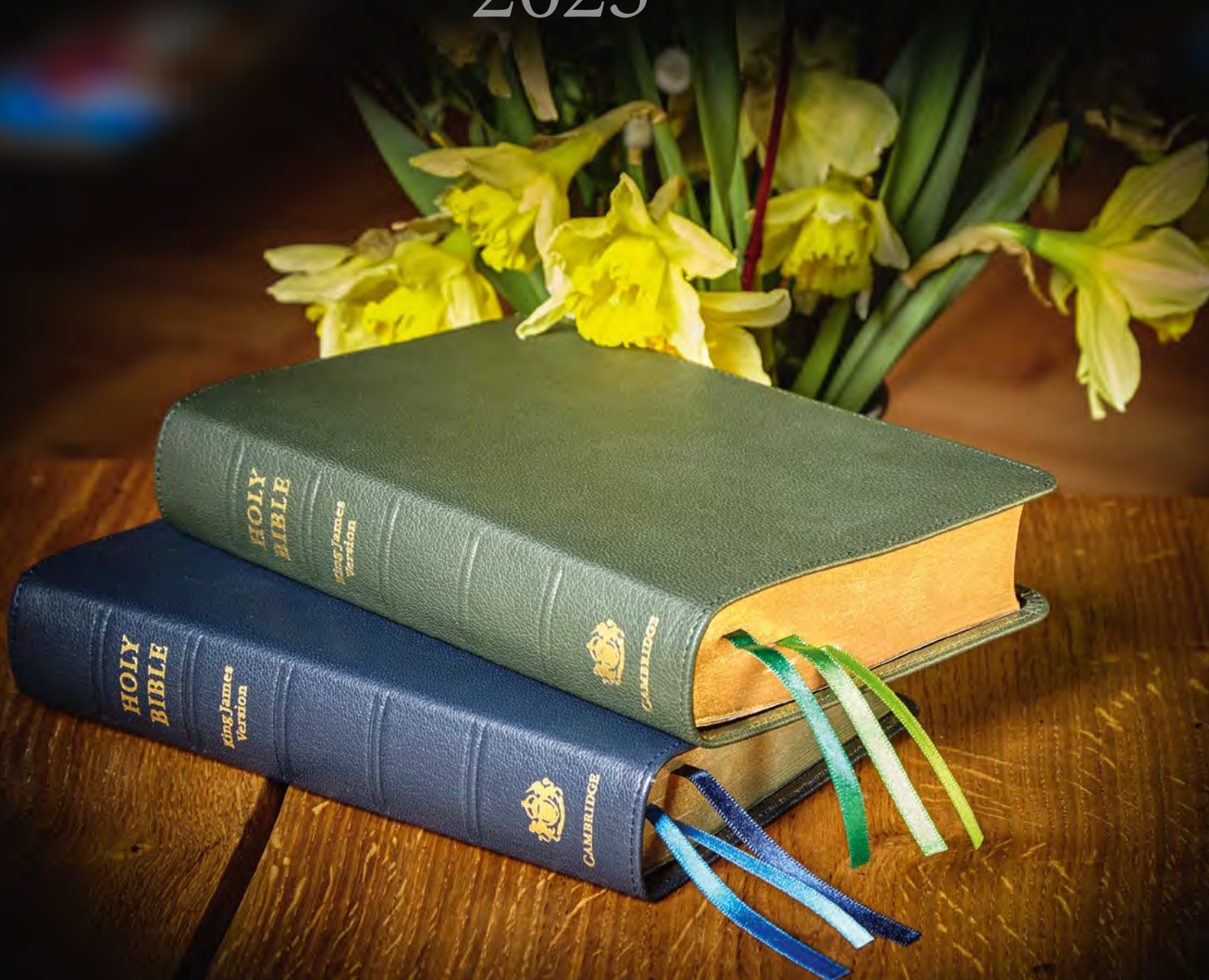

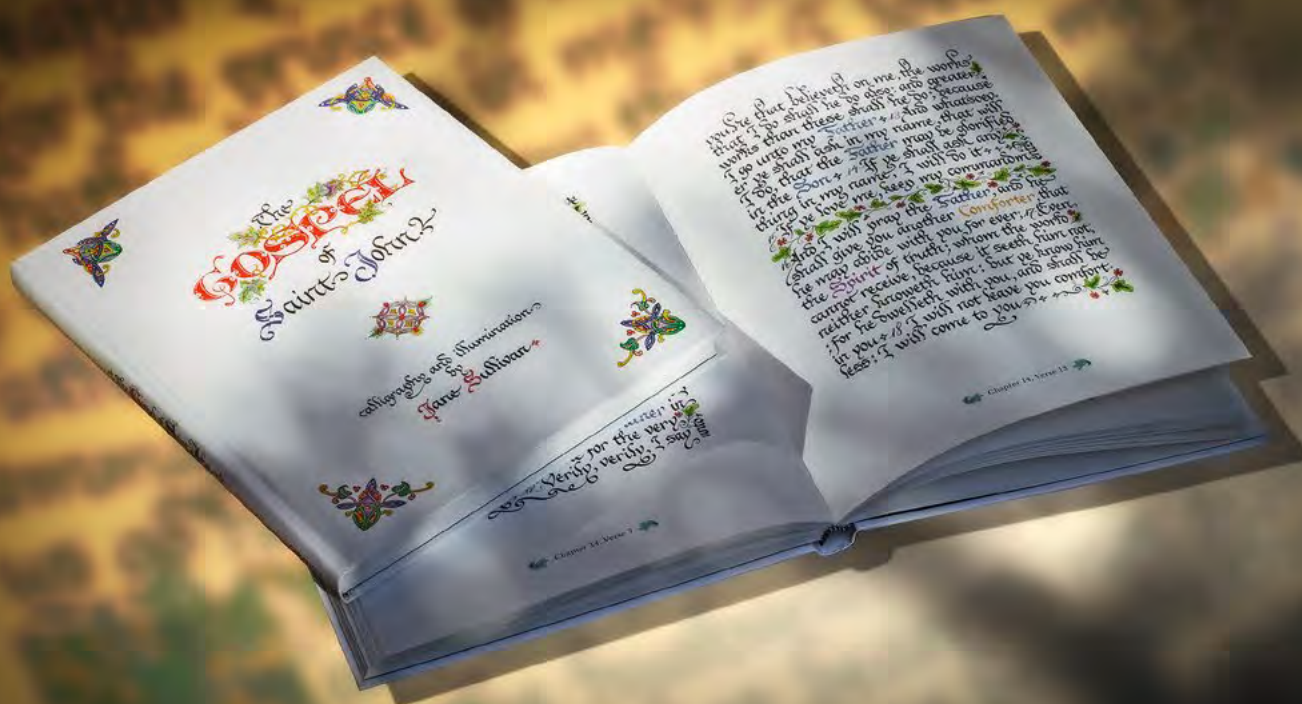
Following the majestic King James Version, the Gospel is beautifully handwritten in traditional calligraphic script, richly illuminated with original illustrations throughout.

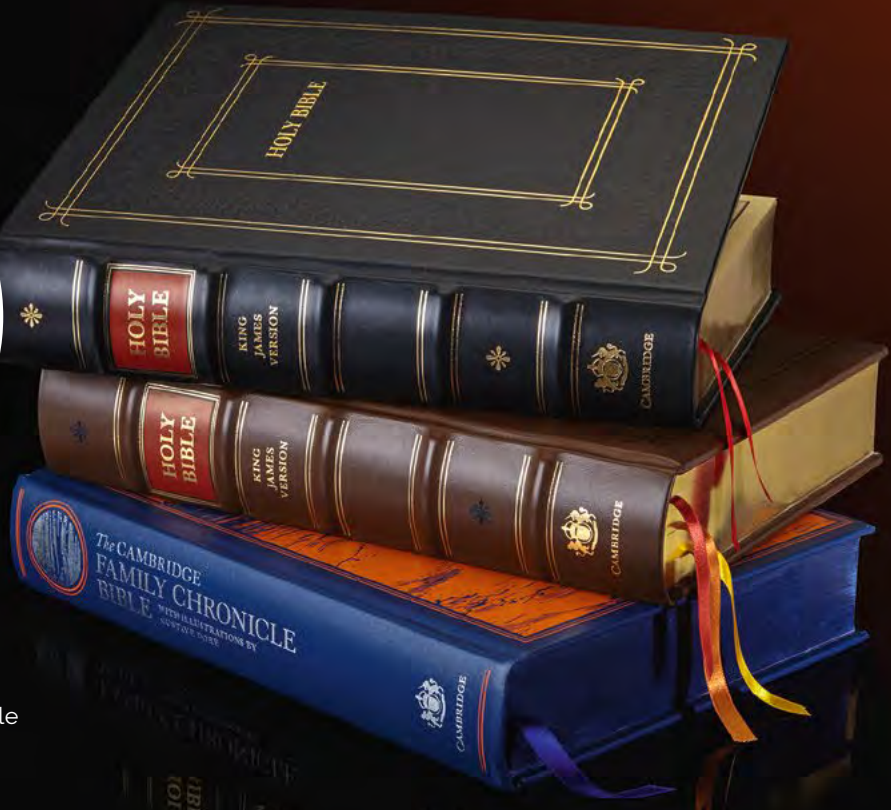
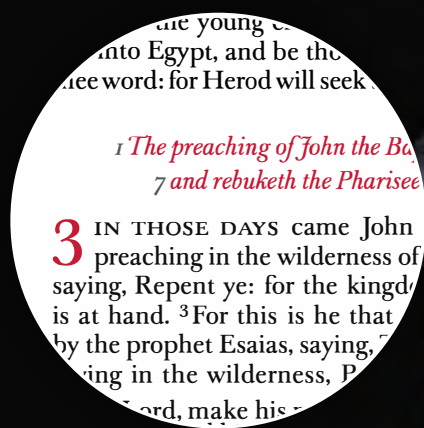

The Bible is printed on paper chosen for its strength and durability, and is bound in a choice of cloth and superior leathers. These large volumes are bound by hand, making them exceptionally strong and resilient. The leather Bibles pay tribute to traditional bookbinding style, with ornate tooling on the covers and raised spine hubs. The cloth Bible has a contemporary look, with dramatic metallic foil blocking.

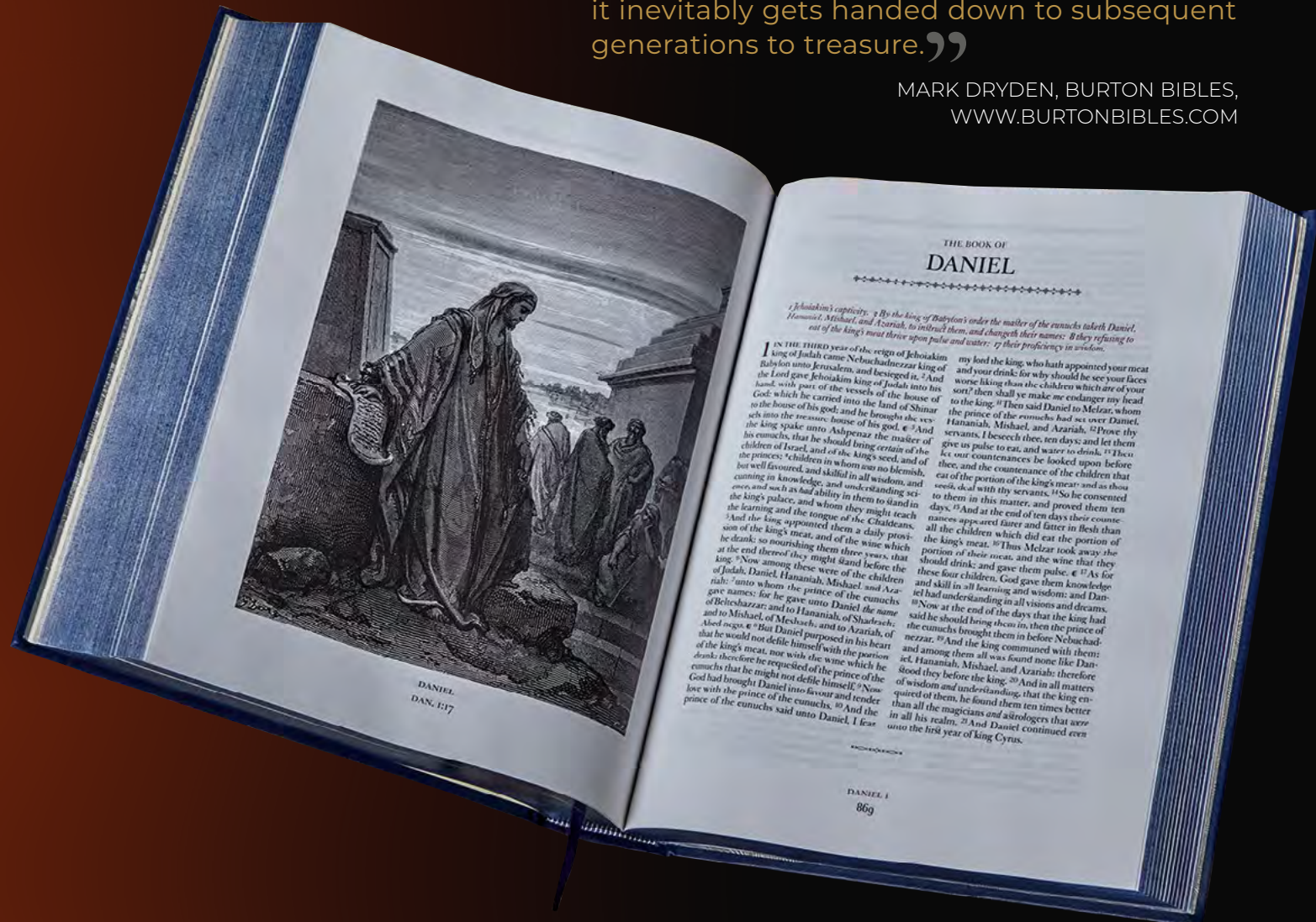

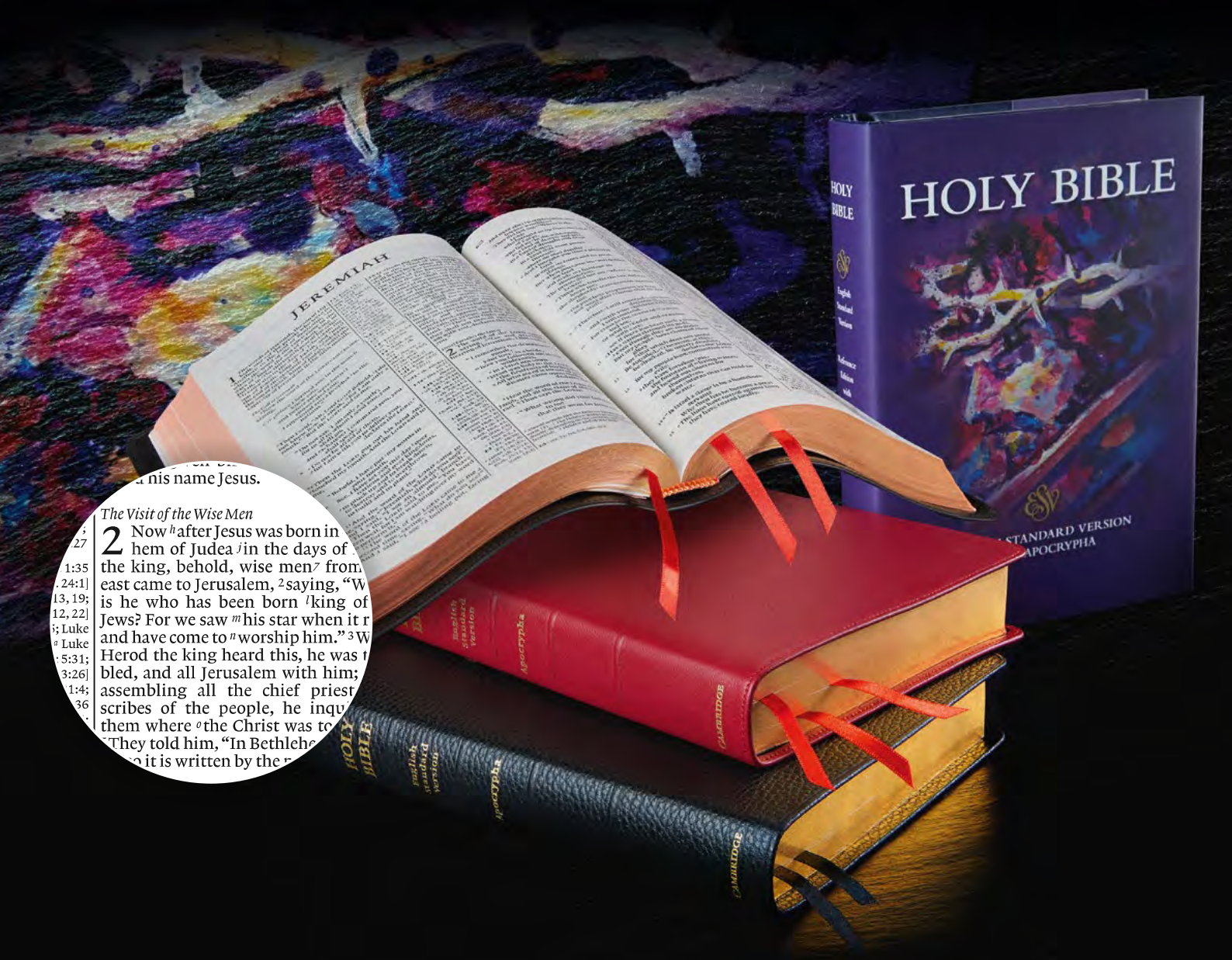

The text is arranged in paragraph format and supported by centre-column cross-references, an extensive concordance, and 15 colour maps.

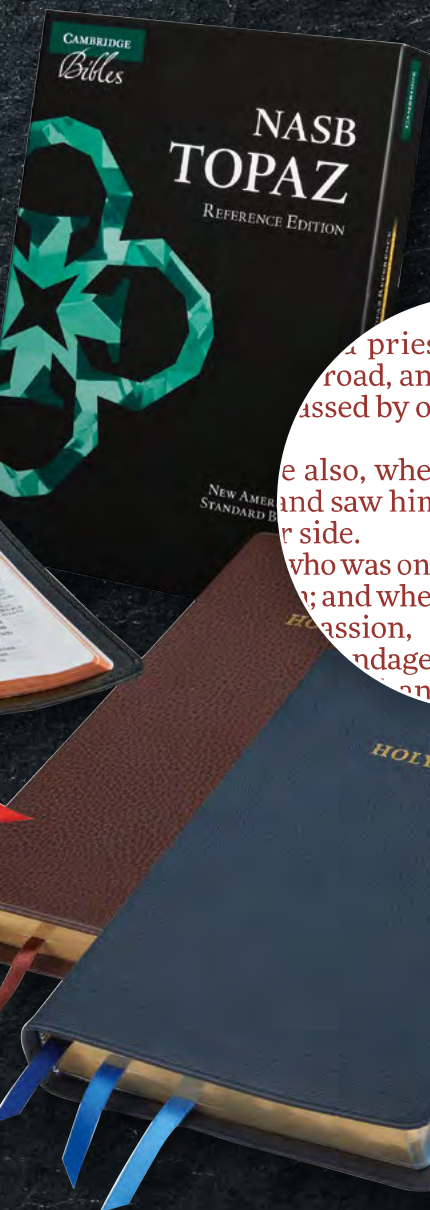

The Cambridge Clarion takes its name from the medieval war trumpet, renowned for its clear and compelling call to arms. The word Clarion derives from the Latin *clarus*, meaning clear.

Every feature has been carefully designed to create a reading experience of exceptional clarity. Unlike standard Bible formats, the text is not divided into columns but runs right across the page, with cross-references in the outer margin. Rather than starting every verse on a new line, the Clarion sets the text in paragraph format to enhance readability.

The text employs a modern digital font which is clear and easy to read. This, combined with generous line spacing, delivers excellent legibility.

The size of print and lightweight paper mean this Bible is compact and easy to carry.

Using the highest quality materials, these Bibles are printed on India-style paper, and are fully sewn, making them not only beautifully flexible, but also resilient. They are offered in a range of superior binding styles.

# PITT MINION



Cambridge's original Pitt Minion Bible was published in the 1930s. It pioneered the use of Times Semi-Bold 421, a typeface designed by Stanley Morison, typographical consultant to Cambridge University Press and to *The Times* newspaper. He understood the need for Bibles to be printed in type that was legible, yet not so large as to make the finished book unwieldy.

Achieving this balance is just as important today: our contemporary Pitt Minion Bibles take their inspiration from the original edition and are greatly admired for being compact and portable, yet still easy to read. They use a digital font, Lexicon, that is efficient at fitting a lot of words into a limited space, yet also exhibits many of the qualities of traditional Bible typefaces. In this way, the Pitt Minion cleverly combines practicality with fine design and elegant form. Slim though it is, it provides a range of study tools.

The distinctive Pitt Minion design takes its name from the Pitt Building, built to house the Press and named after British Prime Minister and Member of Parliament for Cambridge University, William Pitt the Younger (1759-1806). *Minion* is a traditional term for a type size of approximately 7 point, giving text of 10-11 lines to the inch.

*Apocrypha* means 'hidden things'. Written in the period between the Old and New Testaments, these books were not accepted as part of the Bible when the Hebrew canon was set, but are read by Jews and Christians for edification and enlightenment.

The Apocrypha were included in the King James Bible of 1611 and in early Bibles after the Reformation. Martin Luther described them as 'books which are not regarded as equal to the Holy Scriptures, and yet are profitable and good to read'.

Today, the Apocrypha are studied by many as aids and additions to Scripture. Cambridge publishes a range of stand-alone text editions in different versions for people wishing to dig more deeply into these ancient texts.
